Meeting was **called to order** by Chairman Ken Zimbeck at 6:07 p.m. All Board members, Clerk, and Treasurer were present. Also present were Al and Brian Rozelle, Karl Klingforth, Tom Whalen, and Joe Russo.

Motion by Ted/Orin to **approve minutes** of October 17 and October 23, 2007 meetings as presented. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's report** showed a balance in all funds of \$81,004.24. Motion by Orin/Ted to accept this report as presented. Motion carried.

**New business:**

1. Adjust budget to comply with tax levy limits for 2007: Clerk presented correspondence from the Wisconsin Towns Association and Department of Revenue with regard to levy limits imposed by the signing of the state budget. Adjustment was made to comply with limit and Clerk will prepare budget for presentation at budget hearing.
2. Set date for Budget Hearing and Town Meeting to set tax levy: Meeting was set for Thursday, November 29, 2007 at 6:00 p.m.
3. Identify items to be included on website: The list suggested by ME Data Solutions was discussed and expanded identifying suitable items for publication on the website.
4. Develop a job description for deputy clerk: The job description prepared for consideration was discussed and several changes and additions made. This description was accepted as Board policy and becomes a part of these minutes.
5. Identify items for future consideration: None identified.

1. Update by Chairman on dog-bite complaint: Ken and Orin delivered all available documents pertaining to this incident to the County District Attorney who will pursue the issue.

**Citizen's input:** Joe Russo expressed concerns over the increase in taxes and the need to curtail expenses.
