

Minutes of a special meeting of the Town of Leola Board of Supervisors held on August 6, 2007:

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Ken Zimbeck. All Board members and Clerk were present. Treasurer was absent and excused. Also present were Judie Pospichal, her granddaughter, her sister Kimberly Bomkamp, and Tom Whalen.

Purpose of the meeting was to discuss, with possible action, the Town's involvement in a dog bite complaint on W. 6th Court. Judie Pospichal's granddaughter and her sister were both attacked and bitten on separate occasions by the same dog owned by Jovica Stefanovich. The authorities were notified. The dog has been quarantined since the last incident because its rabies certification had been allowed to expire.

Motion by Ted/Orin to request the Adams County authorities to pursue obtaining a court order to kill the dog in accordance with Sec. 174.02(3) Wis. Stats. as soon as possible and if they do not, for the Town to pursue the same course of action. Motion carried.

Motion by Orin/Ted to adjourn at 6:47 p.m. Motion carried.
