

Notes on road inspection conducted on April 16, 2009:

Roads needing work:

3rd Avenue south of County D – need to contact Gene Bula about widening the shoulder by filling in the ditch to accommodate truck parking

6th Avenue north of County D – recover gravel spread into right of way during snow plowing (also applies to any other roads with similar situation)

Ditch on east side of 5th Avenue south of Hwy 73 – need to remind cranberry grower of agreement to deepen ditch so water will flow toward 73

Akron Drive from 5th Avenue to Hwy 73 – needs extensive repair (2009-10?)

Akron Ct. from Hwy 73 to 1st Drive – bumpy AMZ/crack seal job

6th Avenue south of County D – center lateral crack needs AMZ/crack seal. Need to contact Scott Construction about shoddy workmanship. Culvert in this area (east side of road) needs black dirt or gravel to fill in hole around end of tube.

6th Avenue at Apache Avenue – need to straighten up damage done by heavy equipment

3rd Avenue south of County O – extensive crack sealing/chip seal?

Road signs missing: curve sign on Akron Ct. North of Hwy 73; others I didn't catch

Identified **potential Town Hall sites** at Hwy 73 and 1st Avenue; and Aspen Drive at County G

Other:

1. Orin would like to install a culvert to divert water across Akron Drive at his shop
2. Property owner on east side of 6th Avenue south of Apache Avenue – needs permit to install culvert for driveway
3. Reminder to contact Chamberlain about obtaining gravel when County re-surfaces County G. Possible uses: any dirt roads or those needing lift
