

Minutes of the regular monthly meeting of the Town of Leola Board of Supervisors held on October 13, 2010:

Meeting was **called to order** by Chairman Ken Zimbeck at 6:00 p.m. All Board members, clerk, and deputy clerk were present. Treasurer was absent.

Motion by Ted/Orin to **approve the minutes** of the Sept. 15, 2010 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report showing a balance in all funds of \$203,033.15 was presented. Motion by Orin/Ted to accept this report. Motion carried.

New business:

1. Presentation by sheriff candidate Sam Wollin: Mr. Wollin had not yet arrived. Motion by Ted/Orin to amend the agenda to allow business to proceed from Item #3 until his arrival. Motion carried.
3. Discuss, with possible action suggestion for pledge of allegiance: Motion by Ted/Orin to repeat the pledge following the call to order at each meeting. Motion carried.
4. Discuss, with possible action, street sign font: A standard for sign font was agreed upon and Ted will prepare a policy to be presented at the next meeting.
Return to the agenda.
1. Presentation by sheriff candidate Sam Wollin: Mr. Wollin gave some personal history and his law enforcement experience and qualifications with regard to the sheriff position. He also shared some tips for interpreting the summary of incidents report obtained from the sheriff's department with regard to background checks for alcohol licensing applicants.
2. Discuss, with possible action, the 2 sample ordinance for the development of a driveway ordinance: Using the sample prepared by Ken, wording of the ordinance was agreed upon and will be presented for enactment at the next meeting.
5. Identify items for future consideration: Need to amend the stop sign ordinance for changes at 1st Avenue and Akron Lane; need to discuss how to handle electronic waste being dropped off at the collection site and other misuse of the facility; other items already identified in these minutes; for January or February agenda, contact John Siebert, independent building inspector.
