

Minutes of the regular monthly meeting of the Town of Leola Board of Supervisors held on March 17, 2010:

Meeting was **called to order** by Chairman Ken Zimbeck at 6:00 p.m. All Board members were present except Ted Jansen who was excused. Clerk, deputy clerk, and treasurer were present.

Motion by Orin/Ken to **approve the minutes** of the February 17, 2010 meeting. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report showing a balance in all funds of \$170,207.55 was presented. Motion by Orin/Ken to accept this report. Motion carried.

New business:

1. Review, with possible action, hourly pay rate for chief election inspectors: Motion by Orin/Ken to increase the chief inspector hourly wage to \$9.00 per hour effective with the April 6 election. Motion carried.
2. Discuss, with possible action, the need for a driveway ordinance: No action; include in April agenda.
3. Discuss, with possible action, contract for website maintenance: Motion by Orin/Ken to include web development in the duties of the deputy clerk contingent upon necessary training, Town to pay for the training and mileage. Motion carried.
4. Discuss, with possible action, meeting with property owners adjusting right of way on Apache Lane: Meeting will be scheduled as soon as all property owners are available, potentially within the next month.
5. Discuss possible ordinance for poll workers split shift: Wording selected from sample and ordinance will be prepared for consideration at April meeting.
6. Set meeting dates for 2nd quarter: annual meeting/regular Board meeting, Tuesday, April 13; regular meetings on May 12 and June 23. Open book, April 20 from 4-6 p.m. and May 5 from 5-6 p.m.; board of review, May 5 from 6-8 p.m. May will be clean-up month at collection site.
7. Identify items for future consideration: Those already identified in these minutes.

Other reports:

1. Report from the deputy clerk on the content of the quarterly mailing. Deputy presented samples of mailing to include 2nd quarterly meetings, census information, and April 6 referendum question explained.

Correspondence: From Adams County Planning and Zoning Dept. regarding new State mandates for inspection of plumbing and electric wiring in all structures. Include on April agenda.
