

ORDINANCE No. 1-2009

The Town Board of the Town of Leola, Adams County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to s.60.30(1e)(a), Wis. Stat., the office of the town clerk shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed position shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years, s.60.30(1e)(c), Wis. Stat. The appointed officer may be re-appointed for additional terms, subject to town board approval. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for *cause* as defined under s.17.001, Wis. Stat. and s.60.30(1e)(f), Wis. Stat.

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on April 6, 2010. The referendum question shall be:

“Shall the person holding the office of town clerk in the Town of Leola be appointed by the town board?”

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
